The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) presents its compliments to the IAEA's Member States and has the honour to draw their attention to the **Regional Workshop on Arrangements for the Termination of a Nuclear or Radiological Emergency** to be held in Nicosia, Cyprus, from **25 June 2018 to 28 June 2018**.

The purpose of the workshop is to train the participants on the arrangements needed to facilitate the smooth and timely resumption of normal social and economic activity after a nuclear or radiological emergency, and to transition to either an existing exposure situation or a planned exposure situation.

The attached Information Sheet provides further details of the workshop.

The workshop will be held in English.

Member States are invited to designate one or more participants for this workshop. Member States are strongly encouraged to identify suitable women participants.

The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the workshop. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Such assistance may be offered upon specific request to normally one participant per country provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant on whose behalf assistance is requested will make an important contribution to the workshop. The application for financial support should be made at the time of designating the participant.

It should be noted that compensation is not payable by the IAEA for any damage to or loss of personal property. The IAEA also does not provide health insurance coverage for participants in meetings, workshops or training courses or for consultants. Arrangements for private insurance coverage on an individual basis should therefore be made. The IAEA will, however, provide insurance coverage for accidents and illnesses that clearly result from any work performed for the IAEA.
