Expected outcomes

The project will contribute to the development of common European and national strategies for Apprenticeship.
Furthermore, it will explore good practices with a view to developing mechanisms for improving the ability of VET to respond to the changing demands of the labour market.

The project will also help companies optimize the management of their human resources and enhance their involvement in Apprenticeship programmes. This will be achieved through the provision of specific guidelines and a methodology about the development of training regulations in companies, the cooperation of schools and companies, the training of trainers, the conditions of VET provided by companies, the processes of examinations and certification. An Apprenticeship network is thus going to be established, enhancing the links between apprentices and companies, as well as between companies and Apprenticeship Vocational Schools.

At first, the project will be implemented on a pilot basis in the following occupational specialties: Car Mechanics and Cooks, in Greece; Car Mechanics and Hairdressers, in Cyprus.
