Digital Skills

Emphasis is placed on useful AI applications which can be utilized on both individual and business level. It also offers an outline of future professions in the field of Information and Communication Technologies, and provides information on further training opportunities on the subject.

Health and Safety at Work

The program explains the importance of occupational safety and health for a modern professional. It presents, through examples, the different types of occupational hazards and measures for protection against them/preventive measures in order to avoid them. The Program also explains the basic principles of risk management are explained and provides information on further training opportunities on the subject.

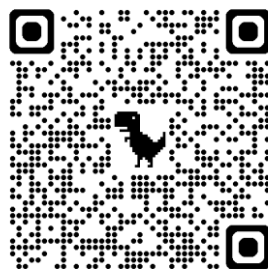
Green growth/Environment

The program analyses environmental challenges (climate change, depletion of natural resources, environmental pollution) and their impact on our lives and explains the concepts of sustainable development, green growth, and circular economy as a response to these challenges. Cyprus' key environmental indicators are presented and advice is given on environmentally friendly practices for individuals and businesses. The programme also outlines green occupations and skills and provides information on further training opportunities on the subject.

Quality

The program explains the concept of quality as the degree to which customer needs are met. The concept of quality cost and the relationship between quality and productivity are analysed. The basic principles of quality management according to European and international standards are explained with an emphasis on the participation of human resources and continuous improvement. The program also present basic quality improvement tools and provides information on further training opportunities on the subject.
